Dear Parents/Guardians and Cadets;

Beginning on Saturday, November 10 at 10:00am and continuing to Sunday, November 11 at 12:00pm, 704 Squadron, along with 173 Squadron and 79 Trent, will be participating in the 24 Hour Vigil at the Trenton Cenotaph. All cadets are encouraged to participate in at least one shift at the cenotaph and we ask to have all cadets participate in the Remembrance Day Parade. The attached permission form gives timing details of the various shifts. Permission forms must be returned on Monday, November 7.

Cadets are to meet at the Trenton Legion (third floor) for the times they have signed up for. Cadets will be provided meals, snacks and beverages during their shift. Cadets are to be in full uniform for their time on the cenotaph. They will be supervised by adult staff at all times.

Cadets are encouraged to bring things to keep them occupied between shifts, such as homework, music, games, books, etc. Cadets can bring a change of clothes to wear between shifts as well and for sleeping.
