Dear Parents/Guardians and Cadets;

This year is 704 Air Force City Squadron's 59th Annual Ceremonial Review and Inspection (ACR). The parade will be held on Saturday, June 1 at 2:00pm at the RCAF Flyers Arena, 240 RCAF Rd, Trenton. The Annual Inspection gives the cadets the opportunity to show their family and friends what they have accomplished throughout the training year. During this parade some cadets are awarded trophies and/or medals and other presentations will be given out.

The ACR is a mandatory parade for all cadets. No cadet will be excused from the parade unless approved by the Commanding Officer, Captain Watts. The cadets are required to arrive at the arena at 8:00am for practice and set up. Cadets are to arrive in appropriate civilian attire, <u>NO sandals or flip</u> <u>flops</u>. Cadets are to carry their complete uniforms with them. Refer to the attached uniform checklist. Cadets are required to have in their possession their OHIP card. Cadets should bring a water bottle with them and lunch will be provided. Any cadet requiring a haircut must do so before Saturday, June 1.

Family and friends of the cadets are asked to be seated no later than 1:45pm. The dress for the parade for military members is No. 1A's and business attire for non-military members. The Reviewing Officer for this year's parade will be Lieutenant-Colonel Diane Baldasaro, CD, 437 Transport Squadron Commanding Officer. Following the parade there will be a reception for the Reviewing Officer, invited guests, cadets, their family and friends and squadron staff.

The cadets are required to assist with the clean-up of the building after the ACR before they are permitted to leave. Cadets must report to Lieutenant McDonald for permission to leave.

- Is my uniform clean?
- Is my uniform ironed?
- Is my uniform lint free?
- Are my boots polished to a shine?
- Are all my badges sewn on in the correct position?
- $\circ\,$ Do I have my name tag, pins & medals (if applicable) in the correct position?
- Is my hair cut to regulations?
- For female cadets Is my hair pinned up neatly with no hair pins or elastics showing?
- Only one ring per hand.
- Only a watch and medical alert bracelet.
- For male cadets NO piercings of any kind.
- For female cadets Only one pair of silver, gold, pearl or clear diamond earrings in the center of each earlobe and no other piercings.
- No coloured nail polish or artificial nails.
- Conservative, natural make up.
