

## 704 Air Force City Squadron Royal Canadian Air Cadets

On Saturday, May 6, 704 Squadron will be participating in a Gliding Familiarization Day as part of the cadet's mandatory training at CFD Mountain View. This activity will allow cadets to learn more about aircraft and flight and they will have an opportunity to fly in a glider.

Cadets have signed up for one of two shifts for that day: 9:00am - 1:00pm and 1:00pm - 4:00pm. Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time. Cadets who have not signed up can still participate by attending either one of the scheduled times.

Dress for the day is warm, appropriate civilian clothing please make sure to bring a jacket. You may bring a water bottle and snacks if you wish and please make sure you visit the washrooms before heading out onto the airfield. You may also wish to bring a lawn chair to use while you wait for your flight. You may even bring Frisbees and other sport related equipment, as long as you ensure it does not interfere with gliding operations.

In the event of inclement weather, we will post on the squadron's website and Facebook as well as send out an email to notify cadets and their parents/guardians of the cancellation. Please ensure that you check before heading to CFD Mountain View for your scheduled time.

From Trenton, proceed through Belleville and turn onto Bay Bridge Road/Highway 62. Proceed across the Bay Bridge towards Picton for approximately 12 kilometers.
